WHAT'S HAPPENING IN MEÐIMURJE?

- **▼** Hotter summers and frequent heatwaves
- **♦** Extreme rainfall and localized flooding
- Prolonged droughts affecting agriculture and ecosystems
- Unpredictable seasons that disrupt nature-based tourism
- Biodiversity loss in rivers, wetlands, and forests

WHY THIS MATTERS FOR TOURISM

Climate change directly affects the quality, safety, and sustainability of tourism in Međimurje:

- Less comfort for guests during summer heatwaves
- Shortened or shifted tourist seasons
- Threats to natural attractions (e.g. Mura-Drava wetlands)
- £ Increased maintenance costs for tourism infrastructure
- Risk of lower quest satisfaction and repeat visits

WHAT MEÐIMURJE IS DOING

The destination continuously:

- Repromotes eco-tourism and green mobility (cycling, walking, river trails)
- Encourages water saving and energy efficiency in tourism
- > Supports projects for ecosystem restoration and flood protection
- ✓ Integrates climate adaptation into regional development strategies





HOW YOU CAN HELP – AS A TOURISM BUSINESS

- · Use energy-efficient systems and passive cooling
- Inform guests about heat safety and responsible water use
- Plant native, drought-resistant greenery
- Diversify your offer beyond weather-sensitive activities
- Work with local, climate-resilient suppliers and services

HOW GUESTS CAN CONTRIBUTE

- Travel during shoulder seasons to avoid heatwaves
- Stay in eco-certified accommodations that apply adaptation measures
- Walk or cycle instead of driving
- Choose local food and low-impact experiences
- Respect nature protection rules (don't litter, stay on trails)
